It's often said that God chose you to be His child. Discuss the reasons why or why not. (Psalm 139:13; Jeremiah 29:11)

Applicable stories: A Time to Live; Second Chances

Describe the times in your life when the Lord redirected you from the wrong path. (Isaiah 48:17; Acts 3:19; Ephesians 5:18)

Applicable stories: Kelly Belle's Prayer, The Bead Shop, You Don't Need It, You Have the Right to Remain Silent

Why should you help others? (Galatians 5:14; John 15:13)

Applicable stories: A Wave of Love, Firestorm, Merci Beaucoup, Waimea Angel

Have you ever had any prophetic messages come true? Describe. (Matthew 10:30; Daniel 2:28)

Applicable stories: Eighty-Seven Percent, Ouch!, Dee, Zoom, The Investor

Describe a time when you had a choice to obey or disobey God? What did you do? (Mark 7:7–8)

Applicable stories: Nihon, Kelly Belle's Prayer

Has God ever given you specific instructions on how to solve a problem? Describe. (Isaiah 48:17; 2 Samuel 22:29; Proverbs 3:5–6)

Applicable stories: Down and to the Right, The Surgeon, A Better Way, Shout!

Describe a time when God rescued you out of suffering. (Hebrews 11:27; Exodus 3:16–17)

Applicable stories: Enough is Enough, Vindicated

How can you resist temptation? (Mark 8:36; 1 Corinthians 10:13)

Applicable stories: The Timeshare, Tempting Offer, The Bead Shop, The Grass is Greener

The Lord can bless you unexpectedly. Describe an occasion when this happened to you. (Psalm 75:6; Deuteronomy 28:6)
