What is Prayer?

Psalm 27:8 (NLT)

My heart has heard you say, "Come and talk with me." And my heart responds, "LORD, I am coming."

John 10:27 (NLT)

My sheep recognize my voice; I know them, and they follow me.

Isaiah 50:4b (NLT)

Morning by morning he wakens me and opens my understanding to his will.

God speaks to our hearts by His Spirit, in line with His Word. His voice comes as a clear revelation or understanding, a "silent whisper", "a knowing deep within," or even audibly.

Pray in Agreement with God's Word

John 15:7 (NKJ)

If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you.

II Corinthians 1:20 (NIV)

For no matter how many promises God has made, they are "Yes" in Christ. And so through him the "Amen" is spoken by us to the glory of God.

James 3:17 (NIV)

But the wisdom that comes from heaven is first of all pure; then peaceloving, considerate, submissive, full of mercy and good fruit, impartial and sincere.

John 1:14 (NIV)

The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the One and Only, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.

God's Word is everything Jesus is. To agree with God's Word is to think like Jesus thinks.

Receiving Grace

Faith is the avenue through which we pray and believe God. Grace is the avenue by which we receive God's answers to our requests as a free gift.

Ephesians 2:8 (NIV)

For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—not by works, so that no one can boast.

Hebrews 4:16 (NIV)

Let us then approach the throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.

James 4:6b (TAB)

God sets Himself against the proud and haughty, but gives grace continually to the lowly—those who are humble-minded enough to receive it.

James 1:17 (NKJ)

Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and comes down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow of turning.

II Corinthians 9:8a (NIV)

God is able to make all grace abound to you.

Every good thing that comes into our life is a gift of God's love and grace.

Ask God

Matthew 7:7 (NKJ)

Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you.

Philippians 4:6 (TAB)

Do not fret or have any anxiety about anything, but in every circumstance and in everything by prayer and petition (definite requests) with thanksgiving continue to make your wants known to God.

James 1:5-6a (NLT)

If you need wisdom--if you want to know what God wants you to do--ask him, and he will gladly tell you. He will not resent your asking. But when you ask him, be sure that you really expect him to answer.

The fault is in us—not in God—when we don't receive what we ask for.

Hindrances to Prayer

Sin and doubt hinder our prayers to God and hinder God's blessings to us.

Psalm 66:18 (NKJ)

If I regard iniquity in my heart, the Lord will not hear.

James 4:3a (TAB)

Or you do ask God for them and yet fail to receive, because you ask with wrong purpose and evil, selfish motives.

James 1:6-8 (NIV)

But when he asks, he must believe and not doubt, because he who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind. That man should not think he will receive anything from the Lord; he is a double-minded man, unstable in all he does.

I John 3:21, 22 (NIV)

If our hearts do not condemn us, we have confidence before God and receive from him anything we ask, because we obey his commands and do what pleases him.

If we truly desire to obey and please God, we can rely on the Holy Spirit to convict our hearts when we sin.

Faith in God's Power

Matthew 17:20b (NIV)

Matthew 9:29b (TAB)

Believe God

Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved—you and your household.

John 6:28, 29 (NIV)

Then they asked him, "What must we do to do the works God requires?" Jesus answered, "The work of God is this: to believe in the one he has sent."

Matthew 21:22 (TAB)

Whatever you ask for in prayer, having faith and really believing, you will receive.

Romans 15:13 (NKJ)

Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.

Matthew 13:58 (NKJ)

(Jesus) did not do many mighty works there because of their unbelief.

Hebrews 3:12 (NIV)

See to it, brothers, that none of you has a sinful, unbelieving heart that turns away from the living God.

Continue to pray. Continue to believe.

Rest in God

To rest in God means to hand over each activity and each situation in your life to Him and to learn the habit of trusting Him to work for you.

Psalm 37:5 (TAB)

Commit your way to the Lord—roll and repose each care of your load on Him; trust (lean on, rely on and be confident) also in Him, and He will bring it to pass.

I Peter 5:7 (TAB)

Casting the whole of your care—all your anxieties, all your worries, all your concerns, once and for all—on Him; for He cares for you affectionately, and cares about you watchfully.

Return to your rest, O my soul, for the LORD has dealt bountifully with you.

Hebrews 4:3a (NIV)

Now we who have believed enter that rest.

When we pray for the salvation of lost souls, we join our hearts with the passion of God's heart.

Pray for our Nation

Prayer preserves peace, blessings, and goodness in a nation.

II Chronicles 7:14 (NKJ)

If my people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land.

Proverbs 14:34 (NIV)

Righteousness exalts a nation, but sin is a disgrace to any people.

I Timothy 2:1-4 (NIV)

I urge, then first of all, that requests, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for everyone—for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. This is good, and pleases God our Savior, who wants all men to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth.

Psalm 33:12a (TAB)

Blessed (happy, fortunate, to be envied) is the nation whose God is the LORD.

God spares nations from destruction through prayer.

Pray for Healing

Jesus died on the cross to pay for the healing of our spirit, soul, and body.

Exodus 15:26b (NIV)

I am the LORD, who heals you.

Psalm 30:2 (NLT)

O LORD my God, I cried out to you for help, and you restored my health.

Psalm 147:3 (NIV)

He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds.

James 5:15a (NIV)

The prayer offered in faith will make the sick person well; the Lord will raise him up.

Acts 3:16 (NIV)

By faith in the name of Jesus, this man whom you see and know was made strong. It is Jesus' name and the faith that comes through Him that has given this complete healing to him, as you can all see.

I Peter 2:24b (NIV)

He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness; by his wounds you have been healed.

Jesus died to buy our healing.

Confidence in the Promiser

Delayed answers to prayer are not only trials of faith, they also give us opportunities to honor God through our steadfast confidence in Him, even when facing the apparent denial of our request.

Hebrews 10:35, 36 (NIV)

So don't throw away your confidence; it will be richly rewarded. You need to persevere so that when you have done the will of God, you will receive what he has promised.

Romans 4:19b, 20a (NKJ)

Abraham did not consider his own body, about 100 years old. He did not waver at the promise of God through unbelief.

Hebrews 11:11 (NKJ)

By faith Sarah herself also received strength to conceive seed, and she bore a child when she was past the age, because she judged Him faithful who had promised.

Focus on the faithfulness of God, Who always keeps His promises to those who believe. Stop thinking about and talking about how impossible and terrible your problems are.

Wait for God's Time

We must be prepared to wait on God's timing. His timing is precise, for He does things at the very time He has set. He will never be even five minutes behind "the appointed time."
